Parish Notices:

1. **Holy Mass** will be celebrated on Monday 2nd November 2020 at 10.45am in Commemoration of the Faithful Departed.
2. **Covid-19 Restrictions:** The New Covid-19 restrictions announced by the Scottish government on Thursday 7th October 2020 did not change the current rules on places of worship. Therefore, we can continue to celebrate mass and the other sacraments in accordance with existing government guidance.
3. **The Sacrament of Confirmation** for those who were in Primary 7 which was due to take place on 28th April 2020 has now been re-scheduled. This will now take place on the **Thursdays of 26th November and 3rd and 10th December 2020 at 6.30pm** (subject to no changes in restrictions being imposed by the government). If you are aware of any child who was due to be confirmed in April and who has now moved on to Secondary School, can you **please let Father Benneth know** in order that they may be contacted regarding the new arrangements that have been made for the Sacrament of confirmation. Please note that these are private services for the children and their invited guests.
4. **The November Lists** – the month of November is traditionally dedicated to prayers and Masses for our deceased family members and friends. The November Lists are now available. Please collect an envelope and list as you are leaving the church. In particular, can you please remember to mention on your

list the names of those who have died as a result of the pandemic. Please return your list and donation to be placed into the box marked "**November List**" as soon as possible.

5. **Home Visits:** There does not seem to be any change to the current rules allowing sacramental visits by the priest to the sick and the dying. However, this must be done in compliance with safety rules, and that those being visited are content with the arrangement.
6. **Hospitals/Care Homes:** Visits by the clergy to the sick in hospitals should not be affected by the local restrictions in the Central Belt, although individual hospitals and wards may be under higher restrictions given the current upsurge in cases. The clergy are now allowed to visit care homes, and like hospitals this should not be affected by the local restrictions but may be affected by individual homes/units/wards having higher restrictions. This allows for individual visits to residents but not yet for communal activities.
7. **Parish Website:** A new website has been created for the parishes of Corpus Christi and Our Lady of Perpetual. You can access it by typing in www.ccolops.wordpress.com on your browser. You can also register to attend mass in any of the parishes by clicking on the link "Book Mass Places". This will show you the different mass options in the two parishes. Then click on the mass time of your choice and it will take you directly to the eventbrite.com website where you can register for that particular event. **Please remember to cancel your Mass booking** if you are not able to attend to allow others an opportunity to attend.
