### Parish Notices:

1. **The Government have said that** from 26<sup>th</sup> April the “50” limit on capacity in churches will be removed. After that date churches will not have a fixed maximum, and instead can take their own safe socially distanced capacity. We will still be required to observe 2m distancing. So, for many churches the practical effect may not be notable. The Government will issue further guidance about how to determine our safe capacity.
2. **Until 26<sup>th</sup> April** the maximum at weddings remains **5** and at funerals **20**. After 26<sup>th</sup> April the maximum at both weddings and funerals will be **50**. All going well, by early June this should rise to **100** and then **200** at the end of June
3. **Baptism of children can now go ahead.** No more than 50 people may be present for a Baptism and so the church should be closed to general public whilst a Baptism is being celebrated.
4. **First confession:** The First Confession of the Pupils of Corpus Christi primary will be held on Wednesday 28th April 2021 at 1pm in the School hall
5. **First communion:** The First communion of those in Primary 4 will be held on Saturday 5th, 12<sup>th</sup>, and 19th of June 2021 all at 10am in Corpus Christi Church. May we ask parents in Corpus Christi parish whose children are due

for First communion, but who attend non-denominational schools to please contact Lorna McKnight, Denise McGunnigle or Fr. Benneth for enrolment and catechetical preparations.

6. **The reception of the sacrament of Confirmation** for those in Primary 7 will be held during October. A date will be announced soon. May those in the parish whose children attend non-denominational schools and who would want them to receive the sacrament of Confirmation please notify us as soon as possible.

9. **Remember to cancel your booking!** - The number of people allowed to attend each Mass is limited to 50 persons! If you have booked a space and find that you cannot attend, it is especially important that you cancel your booking to allow someone else to take that space!
