1. **There will be an online Mass only** on Tuesday 4th May 2021.
2. **Baptism of children can now go ahead.** No more than 50 people may be present for a Baptism and so the church should be closed to general public whilst a Baptism is being celebrated.
3. **First communion:** The First communion of those in Primary 4 will be held on Saturday 5th, 12th, and 19th of June 2021 all at 10am in Corpus Christi Church. May we ask parents in Corpus Christi parish whose children are due for First communion, but who attend non-denominational schools to please contact Lorna McKnight, Denise McGunnigle or Fr. Benneth for enrolment and catechetical preparations.
4. **The reception of the sacrament of Confirmation** for those in Primary 7 will be held during October. A date will be announced soon. May those in the parish whose children attend non-denominational schools and who would want them to receive the sacrament of Confirmation please notify us as soon as possible.
