2. **Traditionally, the month of October is the month of Our Lady,** and I would like to encourage you to pray the Rosary during this month for the intentions of your family and our parishioners.
3. **We will pray the Memorare** after communion at every Mass this month.
4. **Divine Mercy Devotion and Eucharistic Adoration** takes place in our church every Thursday at 7pm. All welcome!
5. **I would like to thank, most sincerely,** all our Volunteers who make time to clean and sanitise our church to ensure that it's safe for our parishioners to attend Mass.
6. **Volunteers are always needed to help with cleaning and sanitising our church after every Mass** – if you can help with this, please let Lyn Gormley or Father Benneth know!
7. **The Children's Liturgy** has resumed and will currently take place only on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sundays of the month. The leaders of the children's liturgy group are responsible for cleaning the hall before and after every liturgical session. They must ensure that hands are sanitized, and face coverings are worn where the age of the child permits that. The parish will supply the necessary items etc. for sanitizing to ensure the safety of everyone.
8. **More Volunteers are needed to help with the Children's Liturgy Group!** If you can help with this, please speak to Lorna McKnight or Denise McGunnigall or Father Benneth. Please note that you must have or will be required to obtain the compulsory Safeguarding Certificates.
9. **Special Eucharistic ministers** who are happy to resume their duties of taking communion to our housebound parishioners can now resume their duties. Please put your pix on the altar and write the number of hosts you need on a piece of paper. Please collect your pix at the end of mass.
10. **Altar servers'** duties have now resumed. Parents will be responsible for laundering the gown that their child has worn and for returning it to the church for use at the following Sunday mass.
11. **Gift Aid Donation Forms** – If you are a taxpayer and if you do not already do so and would like to **Gift Aid** your donations to our church, there are forms available for this purpose at the back of the church. This can be done either by Direct Debit or by Gift Aid envelopes. Donating through **Gift Aid** means that the church can claim an extra 25p for every £1 we receive. If you would like to have Gift Aid envelopes, please speak to Bryan Maguire or Father Benneth.
