1. **The Holy Mass of our Parish's Diamond Jubilee** will be celebrated by the Archbishop of Glasgow, the Most Reverend

Willian Nolan, on Sunday 12th June 2022, at 9.30am. All are welcome!

2. **Parish Diamond Jubilee Retreat** – there will be a Parish Retreat for the parishioners of Our Lady of Perpetual Succour and Corpus Christi on **Saturday 2nd April 2022, from 10.30am until 2.00pm** at the Schoenstatt Retreat Centre, Kentenich Way, Clachan of Campsie, G66 7AT. Transportation will be sponsored by the parish. The Retreat Moderator will be Father Jim Lawlor of Immaculate Conception Parish.
3. **Lent is a liturgical season** of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Attendance to daily Mass is highly recommended during the season of Lent.
4. **During Lent, Stations of the Cross, Divine Mercy Devotions and Benediction** will be held in Corpus Christi Church every Thursday evening at 7.00pm. All are welcome!
5. **The following course dates** have now been made available by the Archdiocese for **Part 2 Induction Training**. Those parish volunteers who have yet to complete this course are being encouraged to book a place on one of the available dates by emailing the Safeguarding Admin Office on **SafeGuardingAdministrator@rcag.org.uk** with their name, parish, and role. The course will be conducted over **Zoom** and normally lasts not more than an hour and a half. **Induction Part 2** - All at 7pm - 14th and 24th March; 21st April; 9th and 19th May; 13th and 23rd June 2022.
6. **Sacraments of First Confession, First Communion and Confirmation** – May we ask parents whose children who are due for these sacraments, but who attend non-denominational and other schools, to please contact either Father Benneth or Susan Gordon for enrollment and catechetical preparations.
7. **First Confessions in our Parish** will be held on Sunday 20th March 2022 at 12.30pm.
8. **All measures that we currently have** will remain in place until further notice – i.e., hand sanitising; wearing a face mask that covers your nose and mouth; some social distancing and church cleaning.
9. **Our Offertory Collection** will now be taken up by open basket. Our Stewards will come round the church to allow you to place your offerings into the basket. Thank you for your generosity!
